

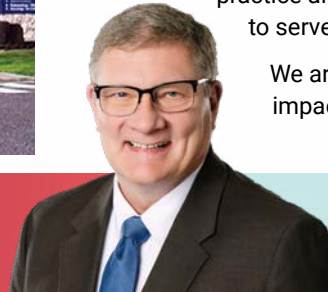

### Donated nearly \$25.7 million in services to those in need

### Paid \$8,282,090 in taxes
